Oxytech Labs was founded in October 2014 in a small town of Chania in Crete. The founders, Jason Vlamakis and Christina Lionoudaki, couple in life and work, having obtained great experience technically and managing, begun conservatively to build and support their own business.

The company started in a small basement repairing oxygen concentrators with only one technician. In 4 months a second technician was hired and the demand of the services was being increased in whole Greece. In 6 months interval (March 2015), Oxytech begun cooperation with a new local medical store (<http://www.bolioti.gr/>) in order to improve and support the local medical services. In October 2015, the company moved out to a bigger store with greater capacity. High technology equipment was invested to offer quality services and another two technicians were hired.

In the meantime, the website is organized and getting online [www.oxytech.gr](http://www.oxytech.gr) (soon in Multilanguage edition). In November 2016, the company expands with a branch store in the capital of Greece, Athens. The new store is carefully organized with expertized equipment and design corresponding to the highest demands of the field. New technicians are hired and administrative staff. The recent expansion brings new customers and strengthens company's authority at the heart of medical equipment. As a result our active customers cover the whole territory of Greece (from Thessaloniki to Crete and the islands).

In short term, Oxytech Labs has begun operation during the financial crisis in Greece and has survived it with great success. During capital controls is able to make transfers abroad, while all the companies are constantly under bank and government control/limit. Oxytech Labs has managed to expand the business activity, make plans and implement them meeting the high technical standards. Right now, the service department is thoroughly equipped and employees fully trained in all models of concentrators.
